Sample pre-submission inquiry

Dear Dr. Jones,

I'm writing to inquire about the suitability of my paper, "[full paper title]" for Journal of Quality Science. I believe that the results we present would be a good fit for your readers, and I hope you will consider evaluating the manuscript to see if it falls within your journal's scope. Our title, and abstract are copied below. I have also attached the full manuscript, in case you or another editor would like to read further.

Specifically, we have shown [key finding] using [primary method]. These results fit nicely with Journal of Quality Science's aim of publishing works on [related aspect of journal's aims and scope]. If you have any questions about the manuscript, please let me know.

Cover letter



Basic elements in cover letter

- Editor and target journal
- Salutation (Dear Dr. ...)
- Indication you're submitting your manuscript, along with its title, and the category of manuscript you're submitting (Original Report, Review, Case Study, etc.) based on what the journal accepts
- Background information regarding your work what is already known about the subject matter?

Basic elements in cover letter

- What your study was
- Why you performed the study (rationale)
- Briefly, what methods you used and what your key findings were
- · Why your manuscript is a great fit for this journal
- (optional, depending on the journal and on if you want to do this) Recommended reviewers
- (optional, depending on the journal) Funding information
- Closing line (Sincerely, etc.) and the name and contact details for the manuscript's corresponding author

Sample for Cover letter

I am sending you our manuscript entitled "Large Scale Analysis of Cell Cycle Regulators in bladder cancer" by Researcher et al. We would like to have the manuscript considered for publication in Pathobiology.

Set phrases and common expressions

Commonly required statements

- We confirm that this manuscript has not been published elsewhere and is not under consideration by another journal.
- All authors have read and approved the final manuscript and agree with its submission to [target journal name].


- If all authors have no competing interests, you should include a statement indicating as such:
- The authors have no conflicts of interest to declare.
- If an author does have competing interests, it's a good idea to include details of these in your cover letter.
 - You might also include funding information:
- This study was supported by a grant from the [funding body].

Submission checklist

Before submitting your manuscript, thoroughly check its quality one more time. Evaluate it critically—could anything be done better? Be sure that:

- The manuscript follows the Instructions for Authors
- All files are in the correct file format and of the appropriate resolution or size
- The spelling and grammar are correct
- You have contact information for all authors
- You have written a persuasive cover letter

How to respond to the comments

Major revisions decision

The most important thing at this stage

you need to convince both the journal editor and peer reviewers you are taking the <u>process of revising your paper</u> seriously.

Create a response document

What to include when responding to peer reviewer comments

- 1) Letter to the editor and reviewers
- 2) Be polite and respectful
- 3) Respond point-by-point to each and every comment raised by all reviewers
- 4) Make the response self-contained
- 5) Stay optimistic
- 6) Check repeatedly for any mistakes
- 7) Adhere to the journal deadline

- 1- Includes a 'summary of changes' at the start so an editor can quickly and easily see what you've done to your article
- 2- Interleaves reviewer comments with your responses. Make sure you address ALL the comments that have come back from peer review, even the small, seemingly insignificant ones such as spelling mistakes and formatting issues.



What is the Journal Citation Indicator?

- A category-normalized metric calculated for all journals in the Web of Science Core Collection, including the Science Citation Index Expanded, Social Science Citation Index, Arts & Humanities Citation Index, and Emerging Sources Citation Index
- Another impact metric, complementing the Journal Impact Factor, that helps you assess journal performance with added context

What is category normalization?

Citation counts tell an important story, but they can be affected by certain publication characteristics. It's important to view these counts in an appropriate context. Normalization is the process of putting a citation count into context by showing you how a paper or a group of papers performs relative to papers that are similar in age, topic and type. The Journal Citation Indicator normalizes for three variables:



compared to others with the same:

Category

Publication Year

Document Type

How does a paper's actual citation count compare with those in its peer group? This is Category Normalized Citation Impact.

Elements of the Journal Citation Indicator

Journal Citation Indicator is

the average of the category-normalized citation impact (CNCI) of the journal's articles & reviews published in the prior three-year period

Articles & Reviews only

- Published in prior three years
- Each article or review receives a CNCI value
- Average CNCI is taken




Like other metrics in the JCR, the Journal Citation Indicator is static for the JCR year. It is created from a snapshot of data at the time the JCR is produced. It includes:




Interpretation and considerations for the Journal Citation Indicator value

Journal Citation Indicator = 1.0

Means that published papers, across the journal, received citations equal to the average (mean) for the category.






- Journals that produce small numbers of articles and reviews may have less stable JCI values
- JCI values can be compared across categories, but comparisons are best made in adjacent fields that share similar citation patterns (within the Physical Sciences or Arts & Humanities, for example)
- The mean Category Normalized Citation Impact (CNCI) is used when items are assigned to more than one Web of Science Subject Category
- Using multiple indicators to evaluate a journal is always a best practice
